**Subject: Action Taken Report Called for(ATR) -586/90/0/2025.**

Sir/ Madam,

The complaint/ intimation dated 23/01/2025, was placed before the Commission on 31/12/2025. Upon perusing the same, the Commission directed as follows:

A complaint dated 23.01.2025 has been received from Rashmi Bala, National Secretary, Human Rights Protection Cell, F-49, Shubham Apartment, Plot 4, Dwarka Sector 12, Near Kendriya Vidyalaya, New Delhi in the Commission on 27/01/2025, containing that:

The complainant alleged that the Human Rights Act, 1993, has not been included in the curriculum of government and recognized secondary and higher secondary schools across India, even after 76 years of independence.

She emphasized that this omission has resulted in inadequate awareness among students regarding their fundamental human rights, contributing to continue discrimination, injustice, and violation of rights

based on religion, caste, race, and gender. She requested that the Act be incorporated into school curricula to educate students about human rights, fostering respect, equality, and responsible citizenship, and urged the authorities to inform her of actions taken in this regard.

In view of the above, the Commission is of the considered view that the education system shall include the Human Rights Act in the curriculum and the Registry is directed to send a copy of the complaint to the Secretary, Ministry of Education, Department of School Education and Literacy, Govt. Of India to make an inquiry and submit the report expeditiously within a period of 2 Weeks

2. Accordingly, I am forwarding herewith a copy of the complaint/ intimation as an attachment for taking appropriate action in the matter as per the directions of the Commission. It is requested that an Action Taken Report be sent to the Commission within 2 weeks from the date of receipt of this letter.
